Open to: Students grade 1 to 12

Location: Glebe Community Center- 175 Third Ave., Ottawa, ON

Time: 11am to ~ 3:30pm. Registration for the tournament is ON-SITE and begins at 11:00am.

Schedule: Registration 11:00am to 11:45am, Tournament Games 12:00 to 3:00pm

Registration: ON-SITE beginning at 11:00am and ending no later than 11:45am

Entry Fee: \$20 per Tournament

- The Canadian Chess Challenge is a national event that occurs annually. This super tournament is composed of three steps: Regional Qualifiers → Provincial Championships → National Championships.
- In the regional qualifiers, the winners of each grade qualify to play in the next step: Provincials. The amount of qualifiers in any given grade is determined by the number of competitors in that grade. **At least 1 winner will qualify from each grade level.**
- Each tournament offers a chance to qualify for Provincials, so don't miss out!!
