The Canadian Chess Challenge is a national event that occurs annually. This super tournament is composed of three steps:

Regional Qualifiers → Provincial Championships → National Championships.

In the regional qualifiers, the winners of each grade qualify to play in the next step: Provincials. The amount of qualifiers in any given grade is determined by the number of competitors in that grade. **At least 1 winner will qualify from each grade level.**

Each tournament offers a chance to qualify for Provincials, so don't miss out!!
