What: The chess tournaments of the Jewish Montreal Youth Open series are popular and exciting events that cordially welcome players of any gender, race, language, ethnicity or creed. Open to anyone under 18 years of age. The Championship is the final event in the yearly cycle. For the first time in 2017, it also serves as a CYCC qualifier.

Why: The annual Canadian Youth Chess Championship (CYCC) is the most prestigious youth chess competition in Canada organized under the auspices of the Chess Federation of Canada (CFC). It is also a pathway to all international youth chess competitions that determines official representatives for the World Youth Chess Championship (WYCC), the Pan American Youth Chess Championship and the North American Youth Chess Championship. To earn the right to play in the CYCC, one has to qualify in his or her province of residence. To qualify for the CYCC, 50% score is required, as per the national rules. Our qualification tournament is the last chance to qualify for children residing in Quebec. http://chess.ca/tournaments
